

SUBJECT: Authorization to Utilize Misawa Air Base Airmen Dining Facilities

1. In accordance with AFI 34-239, *Food Service Program Management*, where such permission does not degrade our ability to serve our Essential Station Messing customers, the following categories are authorized to utilize the Misawa Air Base Airmen Dining Facilities:

- a. Active duty enlisted members (all ranks) may dine at the dining facility for any meal.
- b. Commanders and officers may use the dining facility for any meal to periodically determine the quality of food served.
- c. On-duty officers working/assigned in the controlled area of the flight line are authorized to utilize the Falcon Feeder Dining Facility daily.
- d. All service members (enlisted/officer), DoD civilian employees on SOFA status, and contract workers and their family members are authorized to utilize the Grissom Dining Facility on federal holidays, Easter and the Air Force birthday. Dependents of service members may dine without the military member but must show proof of military issued identification.
- e. Military retirees and family members may dine for any meal.
- f. TDY personnel whose orders authorize or direct the use of government dining facilities.
- g. Service members and dependents of E-1- E-4 personnel may use the dining facility on the weekends. Spouses and children of members in ranks E-1- E-4 will pay discount rate (food cost without surcharge).
- h. Youth groups hosted by DoDDS for officially sanctioned activities. These visits must be coordinated in advance with the Food Service Section Chief.
- i. Dependents of deployed service members on week days, weekends, family days and holidays. Dependents must present a copy of the deployed member's deployment orders.
- j. Special dignitaries to include civilians, military personnel, or foreign government personnel, identified by the 35 FW/CC or Wing Protocol, are authorized to utilize the Dining Facilities as cash paying customers (as appropriate).

2. This memorandum supersedes all other letters, same subject. In case of contingencies, the above categories may be restricted access. Please direct questions to the Food Service Section Chief, 226-3418.
