

# AIRMAN SCHOLARSHIP AND COMMISSIONING PROGRAM

Application packages must be submitted to HQ AFROTC/RRUE no earlier than Sept. 1 and no later than Oct. 15.

ASCP offers active duty enlisted personnel, who can complete all bachelor degree and commissioning requirements in two to four years as an Air Force ROTC cadet, the opportunity to earn a commission.

Upon graduation and completion of the program, you will be commissioned as a second lieutenant and will then be returned to active duty with a military obligation of four years active and four years reserves. After graduation/commissioning as a new second lieutenant you may be required to wait up to 365 days to enter active duty.

#### Requirements include:

- 12 hours of graded college course work (applicants who have 24 hours of graded coursework or more do not need to submit an ACT or SAT) with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- ACT composite score of 22 or an SAT combined reading and math score of 1100
- AFOQT Academic Aptitude score of 39
- Admission to a school offering AFROTC, (including cross-town schools) in the academic major of study desired
- Has passed all components of the Air Force Physical Fitness Test
