Military Spouse Preference (MSP)

Preference for employment shall be provided in accordance with DoD Instruction 1400.25, Volume 315.

When can you claim the Military Spouse Preference (MSP)?

The spouse of an active duty member of the Armed Forces (including the U.S. Coast Guard and full-time Reserve or National Guard), who relocates via a Permanent Change of Station (PCS) move to the military sponsor's new permanent duty station, is entitled to MSP for all positions in the commuting area of the new duty station if he or she:

- Married the military sponsor before the sponsor's PCS orders and report date were issued.
- Must be physically present in the commuting area of the new duty station to claim and exercise Military Spouse Preference (MSP); spouses will not receive preference until they have arrived at the overseas location.
- Upload all required documents: PCS orders, marriage certificate and resumé.
- Provide a copy of the PCS order showing a dependents-authorized move and the sponsor's reporting date to the new duty location.


When will you lose the Military Spouse Preference (MSP)?

- Military spouse preference (MSP) will be lost if the MSP was offered a continuing position and declined. Continuing positions are defined as positions to which appointments are made without time limitation and are required to have a fixed work schedule, i.e., part-time or full-time.
- Acceptance or refusal of a continuing position in the Federal Service for which the spouse has registered or applied for employment, whether or not preference was applied (Note: includes management-initiated action to change employment category from Flexible to Regular).
- Refusal to participate in established recruitment procedures (e.g., interview, responding to evaluation criteria).
- Loss of MSP status due to divorce, death of the sponsor or sponsor's retirement or separation from active duty.

AIR CONDITIONING SERVICES

1. RECEIVER-DRIER

The receiver is a metal container that serves as a storage receptacle for the refrigerant. It's also referred to as a drier because it absorbs moisture from the refrigerant and filters out particles of debris and acids that would otherwise harm your AC system. Commonly located on the liquid line of the AC system, you should change your drier every three to four years to ensure quality filtration and prevent any damage caused by detrimental chemicals.

2. COMPRESSOR

The compressor is a belt-driven device that derives its name from compressing refrigerant gas and transferring it into the condenser. While acting as a simple pump, the compressor is the core of your vehicle's air conditioning system. Our machine checks the pressure output of the compressor to make sure it is operating properly.

3. CONDENSER

The condenser's primary function is to cool the refrigerant. It is a heat dissipating apparatus that radiates heat released by compressed gasses and condenses them into high-pressure liquids. The location of your condenser depends on how new your car is. It is typically found at the front of the vehicle, directly in front of the engine cooling radiator. We make sure your cooling fan is operating properly and that the vanes in the condenser are clean and free of debris.

4. EVAPORATOR

The evaporator is designed to remove heat from the inside of your vehicle. We check the blower motors filter or cabin filter of your car to make sure it is working optimally. Lastly, lines and hoses are inspected by applying vacuums and dye to check for leaks.

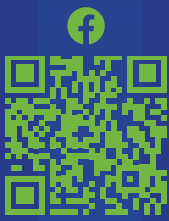

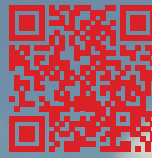

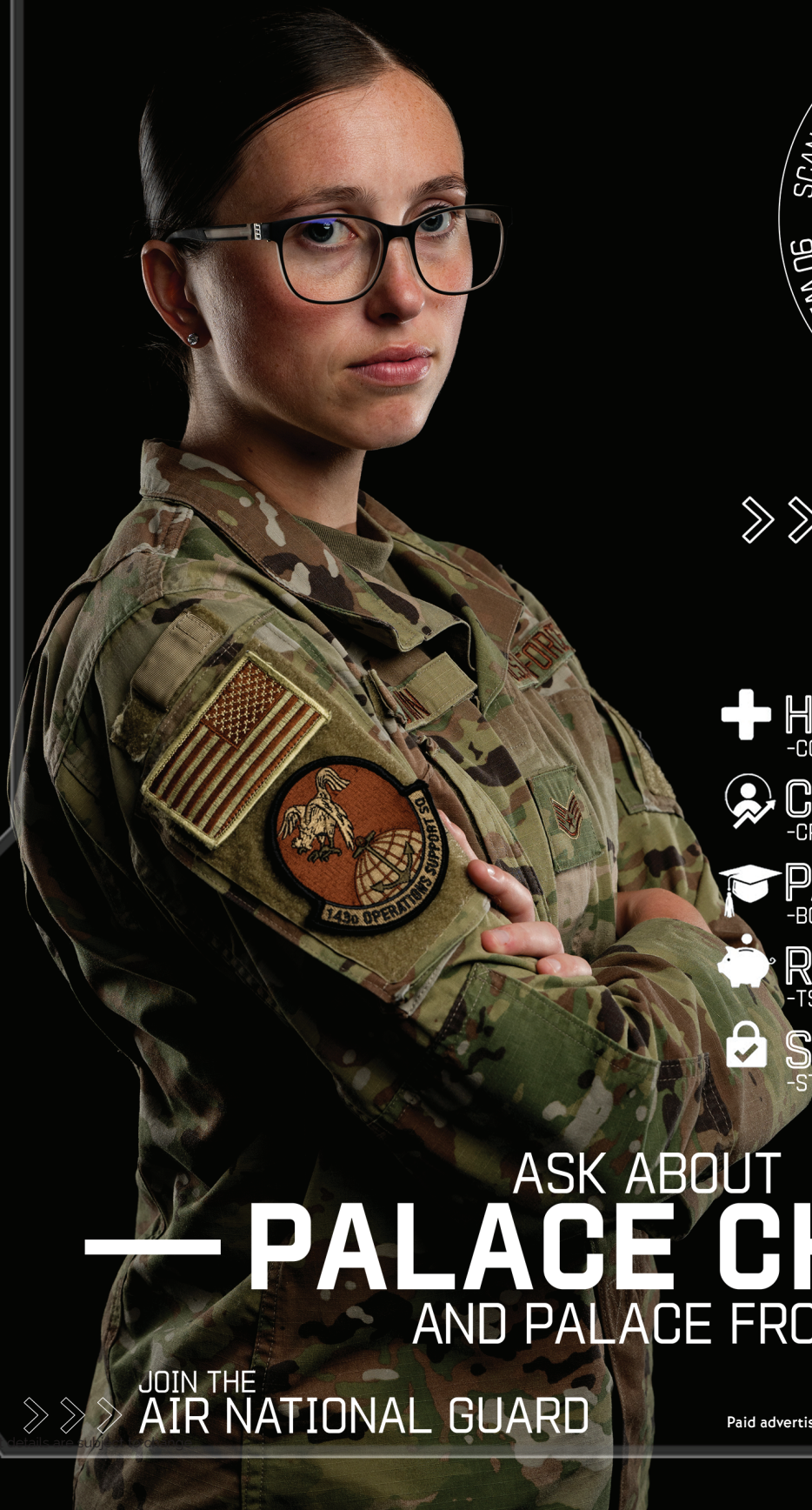
